

***“Sermon on the Mount” Part 11 “What is your motives”***

***Matthew 6:1-8 & 16-18***

- Point One: \_\_\_\_\_
- Jesus tells us in Matthew 6:1 to “Take heed” not to do what?  
\_\_\_\_\_
- If we do our charitable deeds to be seen by men, Jesus tells us that we will have \_\_\_\_\_ from our Father in Heaven.
- In Matthew 6:2 we are told not to \_\_\_\_\_ a \_\_\_\_\_ in the synagogue and in the streets.
- Jesus calls these men \_\_\_\_\_.
- Matthew 6:3 Jesus tells us, “do not let your \_\_\_\_\_ hand know what your \_\_\_\_\_ hand is doing”.
