Jesus tells us to be reconciled to our brother in Matthew 5:23-24, Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and therethat your brother has something against you, ²⁴ leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First beto your brother, and then come and offer your gift.	
Point Four:	
Jesus tells us in Matthew 5:25-26, Agree with your adversary, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversa you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison. ²⁶ Assuredly, I say to you, you will by no means g there till you have paid the last penny.
